

COLLEGE LIBRARY:-

The college is rightfully proud of well stocked and beautifully maintained Library. It has over 62019 books for the convenience of the students. The library has a subscription of 16 Newspapers and Magazines both in English and Hindi. During the session 2019-20 a total number of 2018 books were purchased through Govt. Grant of Rs.5 Lakhs.

The library has separate reading areas for faculty and students with seating capacity of 140. It has a separate periodical and magazine section along with an archives section which maintains the history of the institution. The library remains opened on all working days from 9 A.M to 4 P.M.

Four OPAC machines have been installed to help the students to search the collection. OPAC has basic and advanced search facility to identify the latest books and access the N-LIST resources remotely (E-books and e-journals).

Seven computers and three printers are available for the use of the students. The library also has a membership of N-LIST and N.D.L. Downloading facilities are available for the users. Students are encouraged to make use of the library facilities and help desks are set up to help them in their search for reading material in the library. A suggestion box is also available in the library to get the users' feedback to improve the services. The feedback provided by users is implemented with the approval of the principal.

Mini Library

Mini Library of the college started with only 20 books, but now it has more than 3500 books on its shelves. Although the college has a regular library for students, this one is different in many aspects. The college library does not have exam notes and guidebooks which help students in scoring good marks while Mini Library is well stocked with help books. Moreover, one can only issue one book at a time from the college library, while the Mini Library allows the students to issue books for the entire semester.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE: -

College Magazine Ramneek is published every year to showcase the creative talent of students and teachers. Many students and teachers contribute their articles, poems, and opinions on current burning issues. Ramneek is a platform to hone the hidden talent of students. The Magazine is divided into five sections i.e., English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Science and Planning Forum. Each section has one teacher and one student editor which provides an opportunity to the students to inculcate the literary interests. Dr. Amitesh Boken from the dept of Hindi is the editor in chief. Smt. Yogita Bajaj from the dept of English is editor of English section.

COLLEGE WEBSITE: -

The college has its own website that allows a glimpse of the entire working of the Institution. It is duly updated and provides ready information about the college, staff, library, courses, syllabi, admissions, scholarships, latest news and events. The website can be accessed at www.gcggn.ac.in.

GIRLS HOSTEL:-

The College has four hostels – Ganga, Narmada, Kaveri, and Saryu, accommodating 700 girls. To take care of all the activities of the hostels – there is a chief warden – Smt. Shashi Bala and four hostel wardens – Smt. Gian Devi, Smt. Sangeeta Bhatia, Smt. Anjana Anand, and Smt. Sarika Jain, along with one hostel Superintendent – Smt. Sarla Gupta. Each hostel has a beautiful lush green lawn which is used by the students for exercising, yoga, and other useful activities. A tuck-shop is available for the students for their daily use items. All the festivals i.e., Teej, Diwali, Lohri, Holi, Republic Day, and Independence Day are celebrated in the college hostel with a lot of zeal. On 12 August 2016, the college organized an orientation program for the new students and their parents. A Fresher Party was organized to welcome the new students in September 2016. Students were taken to visit the Trade Fair in November 2016 and Suraj Kund Mela in February 2017. At the end of the session a farewell party for the outgoing students is organized every year.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:-

The Institute believes in the overall development of its students. To achieve this end, it provides ample opportunities to the students to participate in creative activities while pursuing their academic goals. It is a matter of great pride that each year our talented students have been creating new landmarks in the fields of literary and cultural activities. Every year, the session begins with a talent finding contest under the aegis of Youth and cultural Affairs Department, MDU Rohtak, to bring out the hidden talents of the students. This year Talent search competition was held on 07/09/2019. As many as 500 students from various departments of the college participated in 21 cultural activities such as dance, painting, speech, poetry, folk song etc. Dr. Vijay Adlakha, the Principal of the college, congratulated the students for their participation and handed over prizes to the winners.

1. Zonal Youth Festival was held at SDIMT College, Tigaon from 9th to 11 November 2019. Our college secured 1st position for five events, 2nd position for five events and 3rd position for 6 events.
2. Inter Zonal Youth Festival was held at MDU Rohtak from 13th to 15th November 2019. The college got one second prize and two third prizes.
3. Inter University Youth Festival was organized by GNDU Amritsar from 24th to 29th December 2019. In this Festival 7 students of our College participated.
4. 3 days Shanknaad Fest was organized by Gurugram University from 22nd to 24th January 2020. The college won 14 gold medals, 6 silver medals and two bronze medals in different events. The college got Chitrlekha Jai trophy for Fine Arts, Haridas Jai trophy for musical events and Prithvi Jai trophy for theatrical events. The overall trophy (Madhav Sampurn trophy) was also awarded to the college.
5. Vasant utsav was celebrated in the college on 7th February 2020. Around 500 students of college participated in various events.
6. Central University of Haryana, Jant Pali, Mahendergarh, organized Inter University cultural Festival 2020 in which our college won two silver medals and one bronze medal.

SPORTS:-

The Department of Physical Education and Sports is working efficiently under the guidance of Dr. Jyoti Solanki. The students have been consistently performing well since the inception of the college in different events like – Handball, Korfball, Boxing, Taekwondo, Ball Badminton, Hockey etc. Coaching, training, and fitness classes were also organized by the Department to improve the performance of the college teams. The teams participated at various levels like Inter-college, National, State, and international level throughout the year. We are one of the topmost colleges in M.D. University in the field of games and sports.

Following were the representations and achievements: -

- Our Handball team secured the 2nd position in District Handball Tournament, Gurugram.
- In Korfball, Ms. Neha from B.Sc. II did us proud by bagging Gold Medal in All India Inter - University Korfball Tournament and also attended India Camp.

To minimize the drop-out rate of students belonging to scheduled caste and other poor sections there is a provision for scholarships and stipends sponsored by the state and the central government. Sc students are entitled to get an annual amount of 12000+ 2000 under Consolidated Stipend Scheme and Free Books to SC Students. Students staying in the hostel get 6000 additional

extra annual amount under the above mentioned scheme. In the year 2020-2021, 948 Sc students benefitted from the scheme.

Divyang Cell

The college has taken the initiative of dealing with the problems and difficulties of differently abled girl students with sensitivity and seriousness. For this, 'Divyang cell' has been established this year under the able guidance of Mr. Ghanshyam. The cell deals with socio-economic, psychological, and educational problems of 'Divyang' students. It also ensures that students are not discriminated against any disability. In 1919-20 the cell made the arrangements for learning computers for vision impaired girls.

College Dispensary

There is a dispensary for the students at the college. This dispensary is working smoothly under the supervision of Dr. Pushpa Antil, Ms. Manisha Goel, Ms. Komal and Staff Nurse Smt. Meenakshi Arora. Students are given first aid and emergency treatment in the college dispensary. Dispensary also provides first aid facility to hostel students. Serious and injured students are shifted to Kalyani Hospital which is just opposite to the college.

RED CROSS

An orientation Programme was organised by MDU, Rohtak on Nov 5, 2019, for volunteers and councillors of Red Cross Committee. Mrs Indu Rathee Convenor, Red Cross committee attended the programme along with 32 red cross volunteers from our college. In this programme volunteers were briefly inducted about the important YRC guidelines. Students were motivated to participate actively in human service orientated activities and to motivate people for blood, eye, and organ donation. Mrs. INDU RATHEE, Convenor of RED CROSS COMMITTEE also received university award in appreciation of devoted service in the field of YRC for the year 2018-2019.

YRC volunteers successfully completed the Deworming of students in our college on 8th August 2019. Also, a MOP UP was accomplished on 16th August 2019 for the left-over students. In this event the volunteers gave tablets to the students and made them to take ALBENDAZOLE tablets in their presence where approximately 1200 students were dewormed in this programme. The same event was organised again on 10 Feb 2020 and follow up for the students who missed the dose on 10 Feb 2020 was arranged on 17th Feb 2020. In this event 1676 students were given tablets on 10th Feb 2020. And on mop up day i.e. 17th Feb, 2020, 362 students were given tablets.

A district level 5 days youth Red Cross camp was organised from 04 Feb 2020 to 8 Feb 2020 in our college in association with Youth Red Cross Society, Sec 15, Gurugram. In the camp total 100 students from different colleges of Gurugram district participated along with their YRC counsellors. The inauguration was done by our worthy Chief Guest Mrs. Krishna Khatri. She encouraged students to take part in Red Cross voluntary services to the community. The

secretary of Youth Red Cross Society, Sec.15 Sh. Mahesh Gupta, introduced the history, foundation of Red Cross by Sir Jean Henry Dunant and activities involved in Red Cross Society.

The camp included demo programmes on prevention from heart disease by Dr. VIPIN ARORA where students were trained to give CPR (Cardio – Pulmonary Resuscitation) to restore breathing and blood circulation in a person who is in cardiac arrest. Importance of yoga and naturopathy in improving our health was emphasised by Dr. Archana Mendiratta.

On 5th Feb 2020 Skill development session by Dr. RAJESH PARSAD was especially liked by all the students as it highlighted various career opportunities for students. Dr. Sachin from Civil Hospital, Gurugram delivered a talk on De-addiction from alcohol or any other type of drugs.
