## COLLEGE LIBRARY:-

The college is rightfully proud of well stocked and beautifully maintained Library. It has over 62019 books for the convenience of the students. The library has a subscription of 16 Newspapers and Magazines both in English and Hindi.

The library has separate reading areas for faculty and students with seating capacity of 140. It has a separate periodical and magazine section along with an archives section which maintains the history of the institution. The library remains opened on all working days from 9 A.M to 4 P.M.

Four OPAC machines have been installed to help the students to search the collection. OPAC has basic and advanced search facility to identify the latest books and access the N-LIST resources remotely (E-books and e-journals).

Seven computers and three printers are available for the use of the students. The library also has a membership of N-LIST and N.D.L. Downloading facilities are available for the users. Students are encouraged to make use of the library facilities and help desks are set up to help them in their search for reading material in the library. A suggestion box is also available in the library to get users' feedback to improve the services. The feedback provided by users is implemented with the approval of the principal.

College Magazine Ramneek is published every year to showcase the creative talent of students and teachers. ## RED CROSS

An orientation Programme was organised by MDU, Rohtak on Nov 5, 2019, for volunteers and councillors of Red Cross Committee. Mrs Indu Rathee Convenor, Red Cross committee attended the programme with 32 red cross volunteers from our college. In this programme volunteers were briefly inducted about the important YRC guidelines. Students were motivated to participate actively in human service orientated activities and to motivate people for eye, and organ donation. Mrs. INDU RATHEE, Convenor of RED CROSS COMMITTEE also received university award in appreciation of devoted service in the field of YRC for the year 2018-2019. YRC volunteers successfully completed the Deworming of students in our college on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Also, a MOP UP was accomplished on 16 August 2019 for the left-over students. In this event the volunteers gave tablets to the students and made them to take ALBENDAZOLE tablets in their presence where approximately 1200 students were dewormed in this programme. Same event was organised again on 10 Feb 2020 and follow up for the students who missed the dose on 10 Feb 2020 was arranged on 17 Feb 2020. In this event 1676 students were given tablets on 10<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020. And on mop up day i.e. 17 Feb, 2020, 362 students were given tablets. A district level 5 days youth Red Cross camp was organised from 04 Feb 2020 to 8 Feb 2020 in our college in association with Youth Red Cross Society, Sec 15, Gurugram. In the camp total 100 students from different colleges of Gurugram district participated along with their YRC counsellors. The inauguration was done by our worthy Chief Guest Mrs. Krishna Khatri. She encouraged students to take part in Red Cross voluntary services to the community. The secretary of Youth Red Cross Society, Sec 15 Sh Mahesh Gupta, introduced the historical foundation of Red Cross by Sir Jean Henry Dunant and activities involved in Red Cross Society.

The core purpose of Legal Literacy Cell is to create legal awareness among young minds and to identify the problems of the fellow citizens in the neighbourhood Legal Literacy Cell activities are organised in accordance with the guidelines of Haryana State Legal Services Authority (HALSA)/DGHE Students can prove to be an extremely valuable assets in the dissemination of information about the laws.

Intra College A multi activity event were organized on February 13, 2020, and the activities included- Slogan Writing, Essay Writing, Poetic Recitations, Skit, Quiz, On the Spot Painting, Speech/Declamations, Debate, Power Point Presentations and Documentary. 17 Topics were covered under these competitions. Winners of the events participated in District Level Competitions at Dronacharya College, Gurugram on February 28, 2020. Students won First prize in PPT, Documentary, Debate, Skit, On the Spot Painting, Essay Writing and Second Position in Quiz, Speech, Slogan Writing, Poetry. ## WOMEN CELL

Women Cell conducted a lecture on Women Empowerment in September 2019 by Mrs Sonika Khurana- Life Coach. In October, Poshan Maah was celebrated and Mrs. Sikandera Devi, Assistant Professor, Home Science Department delivered a lecture on 'Health and Nutrition'. Later, another lecture was conducted in October by Dr Renu Yadav where she talked about the issue of female hygiene. A basic health medical check-up was organized in association with Aarvi Hospital which benefitted around 200 girls. A Two-Day free eye check-up camp was organised in association with Dyal Eye and Maternity Hospital in October. In addition to this, another activity was organised in the same month wherein the girls were guided to put up Mehendi Stalls on the eve of Karvachauth. In January 2020, a 3-day workshop on 'Mental Health Issues' was organised for day scholars and hostel girls by the counsellors from Fortis Hospital, Gurugram. Another 2 days basic medical health check-up camp was organised for day scholars and hostel girls in association with Jankateshwara Hospital, Delhi in which 400 girls got their free health check-up done in February. A lecture on 'Career in Army' was delivered by Colonel Sandeep Ahlawat to motivate the girls to join the army. One week workshop on 'Developing Life Skills' was organised in association with Sri Satya Sai organization. The girls were taken to the Red-Cross Society School for deaf and Dumb, Gurugram for instilling the value of Social Service in them. Around 75 girls interacted with the special kids and learnt a lot from their experiences. Apart from the lectures and workshop, women cell organised competitions like pot decoration etc. for honing the artistic skills of the girls.

## SC Cell

The college has an SC cell which safeguards the interests of Scheduled Caste Students. The cell ensures the implementation of the reservation policy with regard to the admission of the students. It also works as a grievance redressal Cell for the Grievances of SC students and employees of the college. To minimize the drop-out rate of students belonging to scheduled caste and other economically deprived sections there is a provision for scholarships and stipends sponsored by the state and the central government. Sc students are entitled to get an annual amount of 12000+ 2000 under Consolidated Stipend Scheme and Free Books to SC Students. Students staying in the hostel get 6000 additional annual amount under the above mentioned scheme. In the year 2021-22, 823 Sc students benefitted from the scheme.

## Placement Cell Activities(2021-22)
