

Mega Placement Fair 2026 Gurugram Division: Connects 800 Students with Top Recruiters GURUGRAM, February 10, 2026 In a significant boost to regional employment, the Govt College for Girls, Sec-14, successfully organized a Mega Placement Fair 2026 of Gurugram Division today at their campus. The event, which drew participation from multiple colleges within the division, provided a vital platform for approximately 800 students to kickstart their professional journeys.
