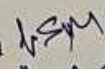
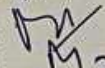
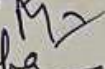
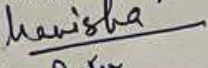
The members actively participated in the discussion and deliberated on various strategies for implementing NEP 2020 in the institution.
