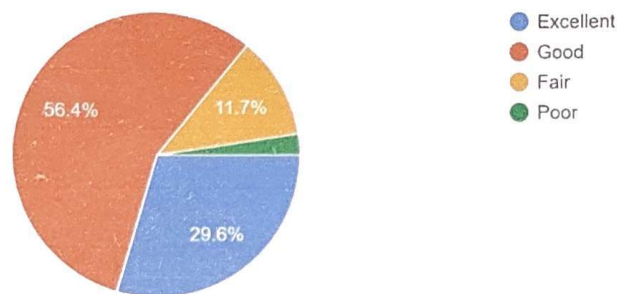

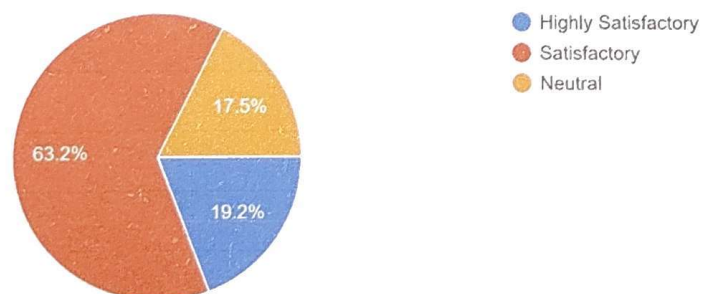
1. Parents feedback, analysis and action taken

Analysis: Parents are highly satisfied.

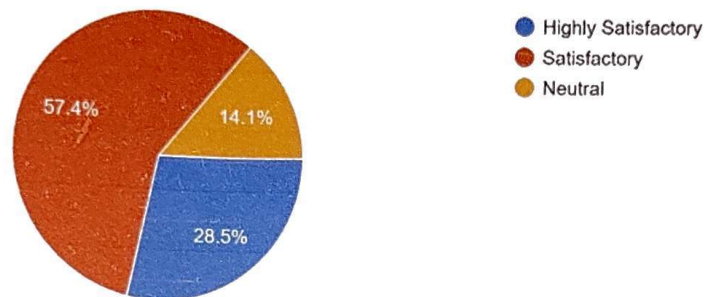
Student counseling and Guidance

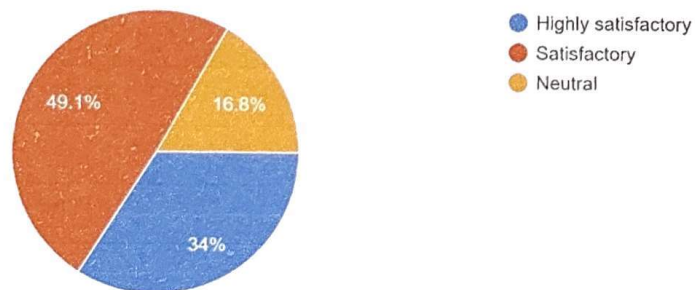
Academic Discipline(timely conduct of lectures, practicals and related activities)

Action taken Report: Small sessions to recover Covid gap is responsible for this, onwards it will be regular and it will be checked by IQAC cell regularly.

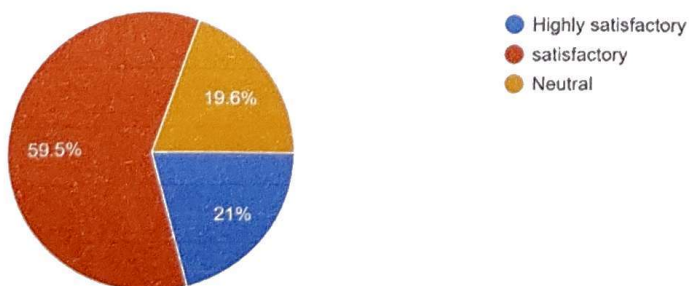
Examination system in the college

Action taken report: As we are not autonomous body we follow Gurugram university pattern for examination but Internal assessment procedures can be changed and made more transparent for students.

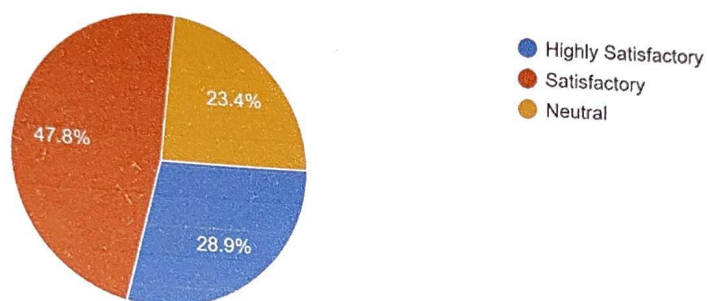
The contents and design of curriculum

Availability of laboratory, library and other infrastructural facilities in college

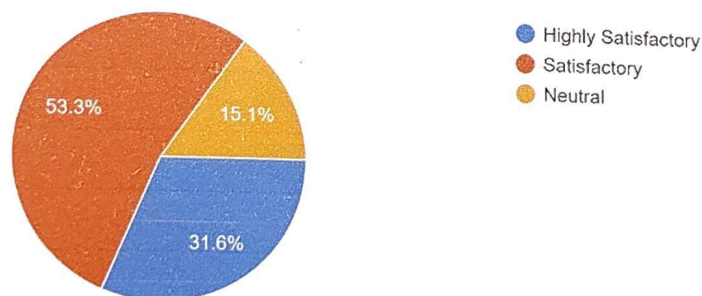

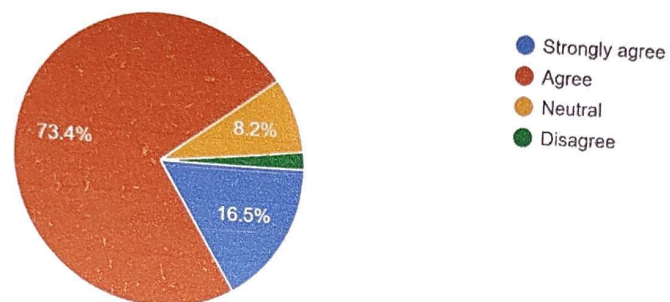


Analysis: 15% parents are not satisfied.

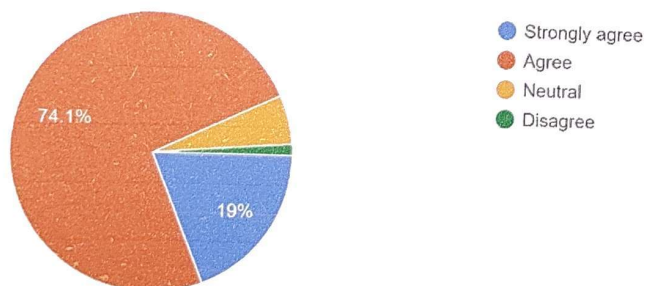

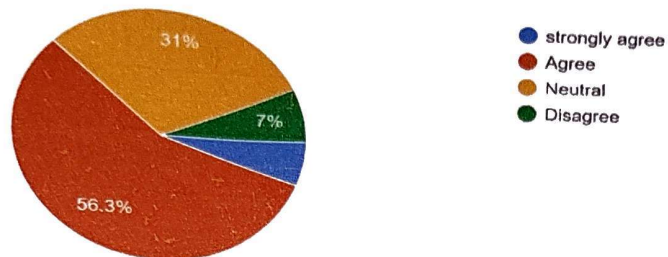

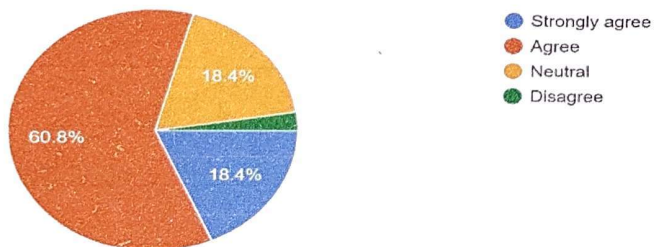

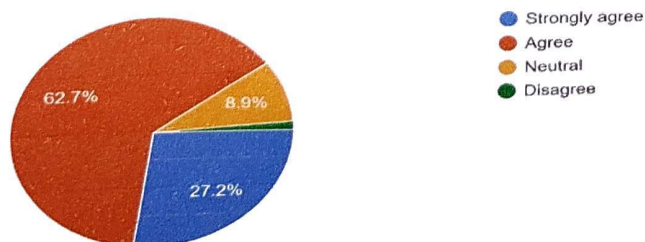

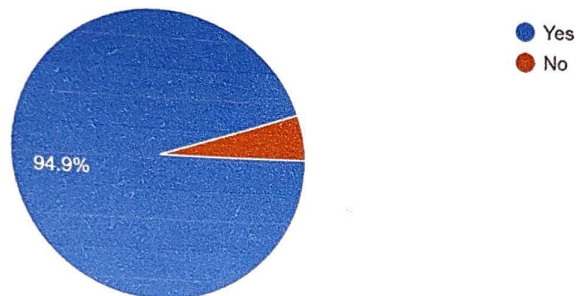

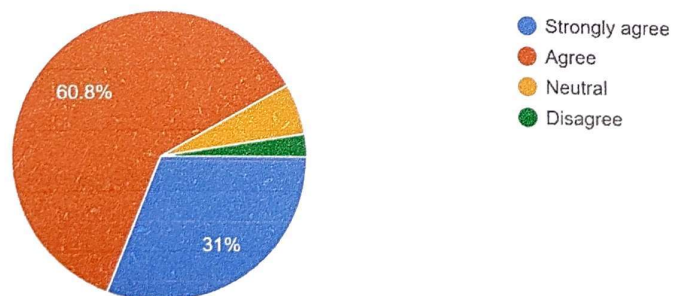

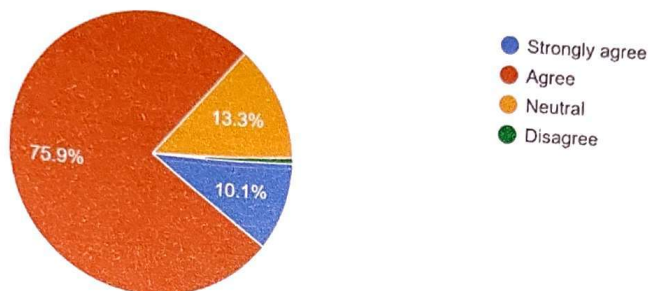

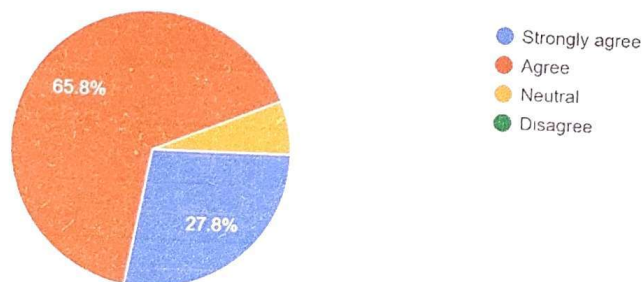

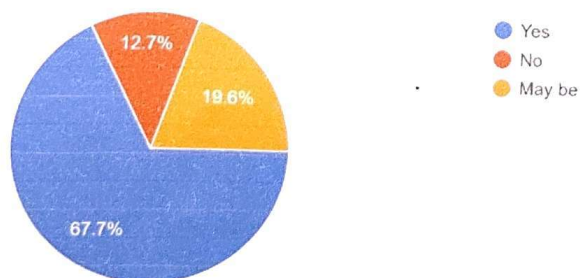

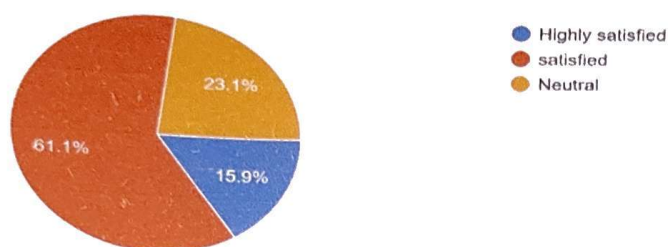

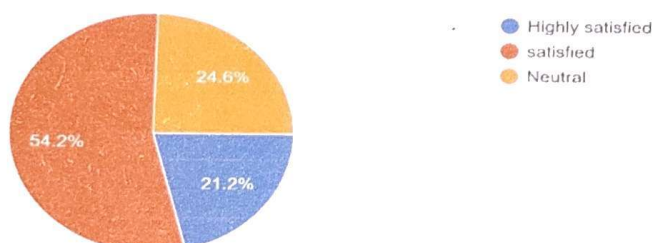
Overall content and design of the Curriculum by the university.

Action taken: As we are not autonomous body we follow Gurugram university curriculum but this feedback will be represented by College council at university level.

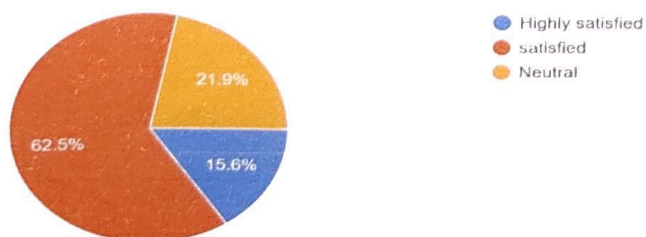
Availability of prescribed books and reference material provided by teachers during online teaching

Action taken: As the question is asked for online classes very less no of students attended online classes.

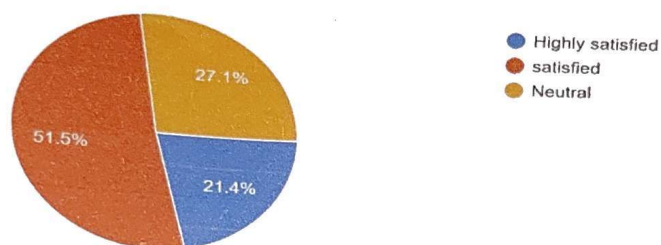
Evaluation scheme designed for each of the course.

Action taken: Students suggestions will be incorporated for internal evaluation and scheme will be displayed before evaluation to make system transparent.

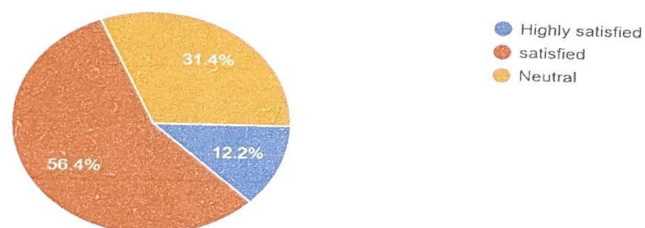
Laboratory facilities in the college

Action taken: Though we are dependent on Higher education for lab up gradation but still proper utilization of lab augmentation grant is done to upgrade labs.

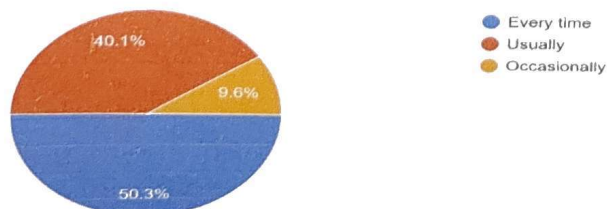
Relevance of contents of curriculum to industry requirements

Action taken: We are following University curriculum but we will suggest these suggestion through College council meeting.

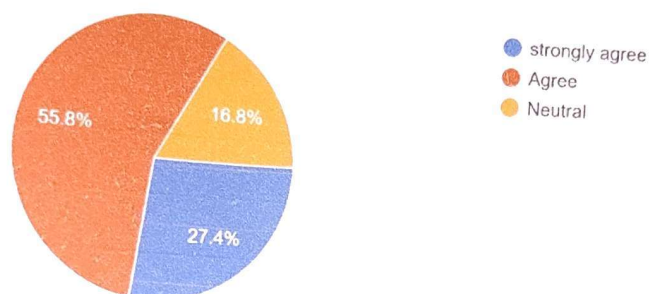
The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

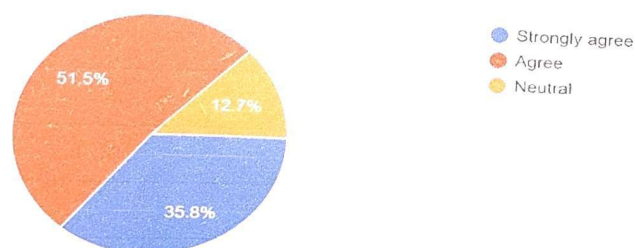


Analysis: 19% not satisfied.

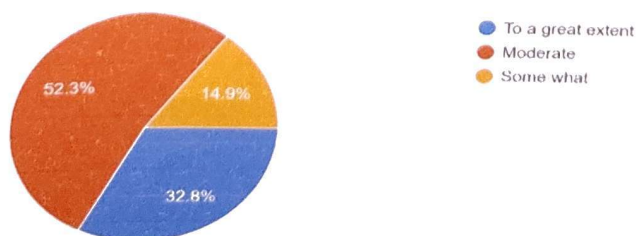


Analysis: 13% students are not satisfied.

Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ-ability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

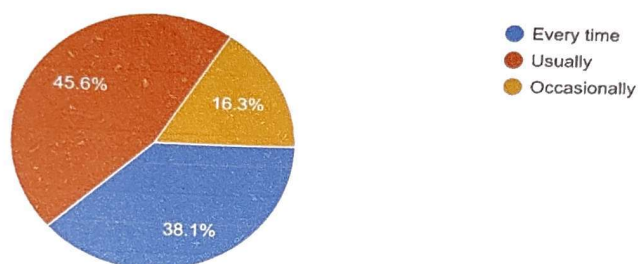

Action taken: Skill development programs will be introduced in college from next session.

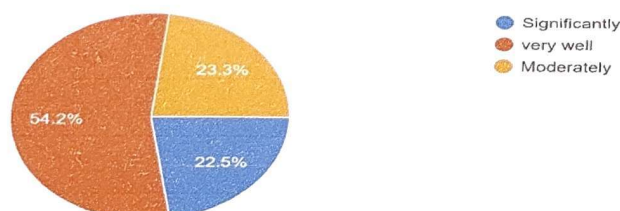
Teachers/institution inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

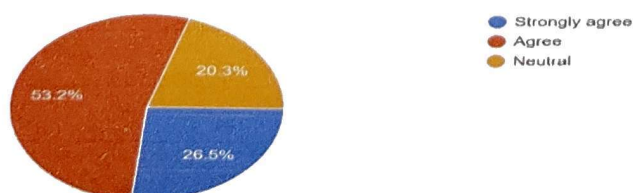


Analysis: 23% students are not satisfied.

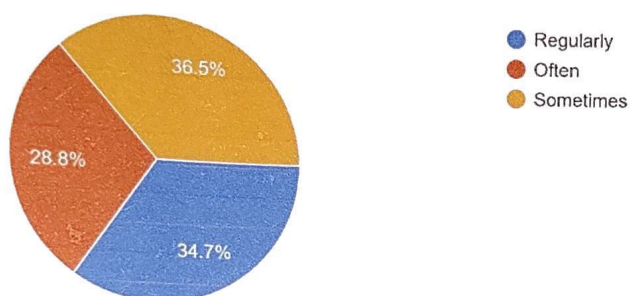


Analysis: 23% students gave neutral response.

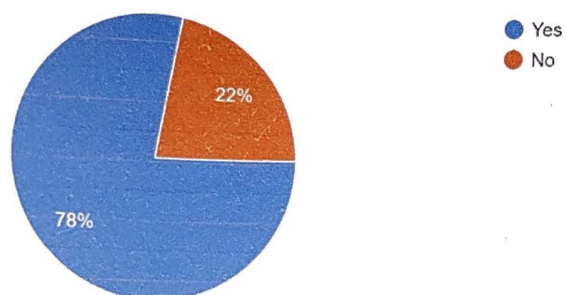

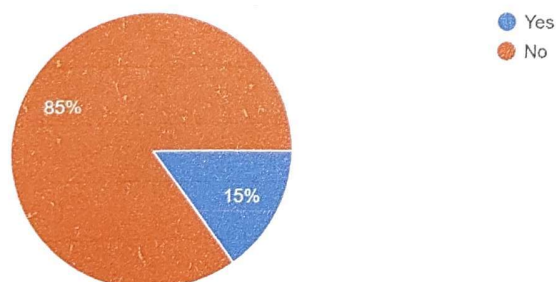

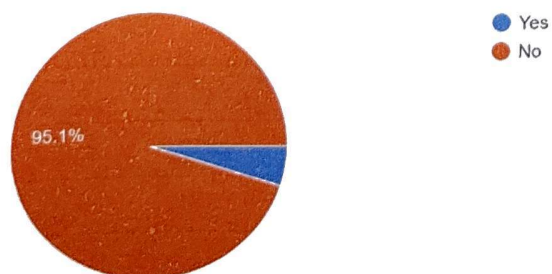

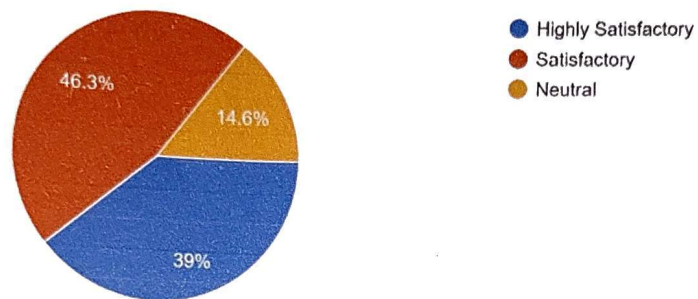
Presently employed

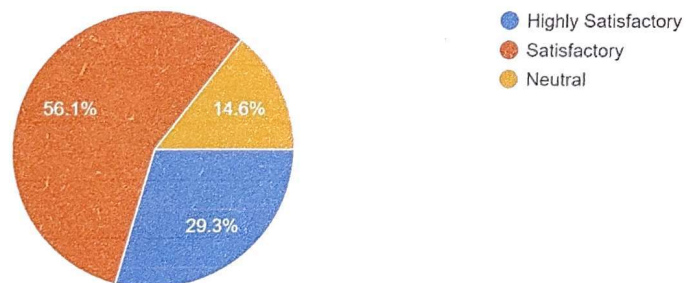


Cooperation from teachers and other college staff

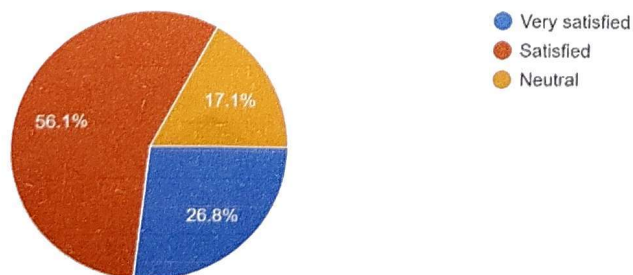


Analysis: Maximum students are satisfied.

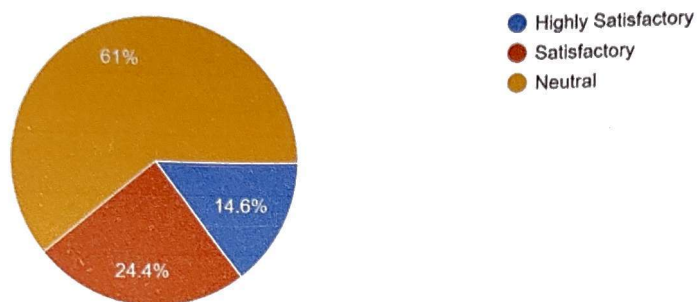


Satisfaction with the overall facilities available as per curriculum provided to you by college

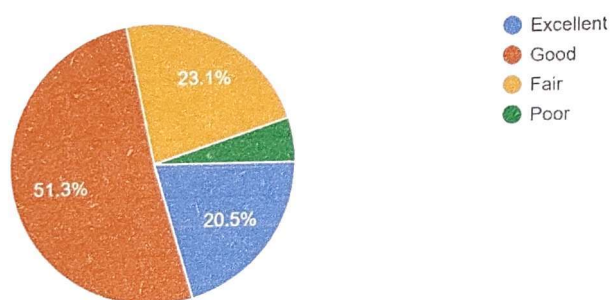
Relevance of content of curriculum with current job/ Occupation

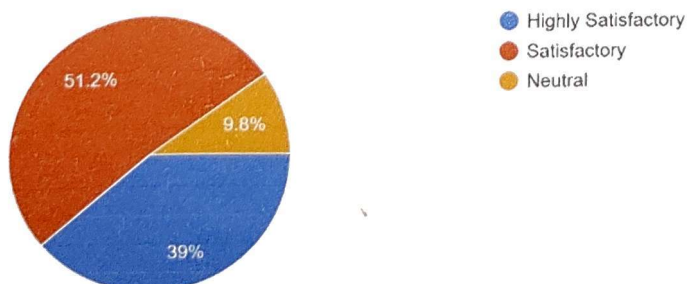
Infrastructure, lab and library facilities available in the college




