The Government of Haryana is organizing a State-Level Exhibition on the **New Criminal Laws** at Mela Ground, Kurukshetra from **3rd to 7th October 2025**, which will be formally inaugurated on **3rd October 2025** by the **Hon'ble Union Home Minister**, signifying an important milestone in public information, dissemination and sensitization regarding these landmark legislative measures. The Exhibition is intended to present and elucidate the key provisions, salient features and transformative reforms embodied in the revised legal framework, with particular focus on the three path-breaking enactments, namely the *Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023*, the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023*, and the *Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023*.

The Exhibition will feature a wide array of informative stalls set up by various departments of the Government of Haryana, including, inter alia, the Police, Prosecution, State Forensic Science Laboratory (SFSL), Health, Prisons and other key departments / agencies. It will include demonstrations, showcasing the changes introduced in the criminal justice system, the improvements in law-enforcement, the modernization of forensic capabilities, and the measures undertaken to ensure expeditious justice delivery and enhanced protection of citizens' rights.
