College Profile

Government College, sector - 14, Gurugram has a unique distinction of its foundation being laid by the First Prime Minister of India Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru in 1959. The college was blessed by the benign presence of the First President of India Dr. Rajender Prasad on its first convocation. The First Woman Prime Minister of India, Smt. Indira Gandhi also graced this college by her visit. Among other significant personalities who visited this college was Giani Jail Singh, the fifth President of India.

The college campus has a nice ambience of greenery, immaculate lawns and a beautiful well-maintained campus sprawling over 32 acres. The college has four girls' hostels named after famous rivers of India Ganga, Narmada, Kaveri and Saryu. Besides all the infrastructural modern facilities, the college has become a byword of excellence, intellectual and academic striving, vibrant extra-curricular activities and a wide range of sports activities like Chess, Archery, Basketball, Football, Judo, Cricket, Badminton and Athletics to nurture and create new future talent amongst the young girls of the region. These young girls have been bringing laurels to the college in the form of trophies and medals, be it academics, music, cultural or sports activities.

Ever since its inception, the college has been rated as one of the best colleges in the field of education in the region. Thousands of young men and women who passed through the portals of this great institution have made a mark in their personal as well as professional lives and are enjoying a coveted status in society both at home and abroad. At present, the college has over 7027 students on its rolls.

With a rich heritage of moral and cultural values of over 60 years and constant upgradation in the field of education, many new job oriented and vocational courses have been added to the existing conventional courses.

College Staff

The college has a team of fully qualified, competent and devoted staff working under the dynamic leadership of the Principal Dr. Ramesh Kumar Garg. There are 114 Assistant/ Associate Professors, three clerks, three lab assistants, six junior lab attendants, one restorer, one TWI, one nurse, three sweepers two peons and one chowkidar.

College Bursar

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college is rightfully proud of well stocked and beautifully maintained Library. It has over 62019 books for the convenience of students. The library subscribes 16 newspapers and magazines both in English and Hindi. During the session 2019-20 and 2020-21 a total number of 2018 books were purchased through Govt. Grant of Rs.5 Lakhs.

The library has separate reading areas for the faculty and students with a seating of 140. It has a separate periodical and magazine section along with an archives section that maintains the history of the institution. The library remains open on working days from 9A.M to 4P.M.

Four OPAC machines have been installed to help the students to search the collection. OPAC has basic and advance search facility to identify the latest books and access the N-LIST resources remotely. (e-book and e-journals).

Seven computers and three printers are available for the use of students. The library is also a membership of N-LIST and N.D.L. Downloading facilities are available for the uses. Students are encouraged to make use of the library facilities and help desks are set up to help them in their search for reading material in the library. A suggestion box is also available in the library to get the users feedback to improve the services. The feedback provided by users is implemented with the approval of the principal.

Mini Library

Mini Library of the college started with only 20 books, but now it has more than 3500 books on its shelves. Although the college has a regular library for students, this one is different in many aspects. The college library does not have exam notes and guide which actually help students in scoring good marks while Mini Library is well stocked with help books. Moreover, one can only issue one book at a time from the college library, while the Mini Library allows the books to be issued for the entire semester.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

College Magazine '*Ramneek*' is published every year to showcase the creative talent of students and teachers. Many students and teachers contribute their articles, poems and their opinion on current burning issues. '*Ramneek*' is a platform to hone the hidden talent of creative writing of students. The Magazine is divided into five sections i.e., English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Science and Planning Forum. Each section has one teacher and one student editor which provides an opportunity to the students to inculcate the literary interest. *Dr. Amitesh Boken* from the dept. of Hindi is the editor in chief and *Smt. Yogita Bajaj* from the dept of English is the editor of English section.

College Website

The college has its own website that allows a glimpse of the entire working of the Institution. It is duly updated and provides ready information about the college staff, library, courses, syllabi, admissions, scholarships, latest news and events. Girls Hostel

There are 5 Hostels in the college premises. In the year of 2020 due to covid, the hostel was mostly closed and very less activity took place. Students enjoyed a fresher's party on 12th February 2021. DJ Party, Mouth watering Snacks, Dance and gala dinner was arranged. One new hostel construction was in progress.

Sports

The department of Physical Education and Sports is working efficiently under the guidance of *Ms. Jyoti Solanki*. The students of the college have been consistently performing well since the inception of the college in different events like Handball, Korfbal, Boxing, Taekwondo, Ball Badminton, Hockey etc. Coaching, training and fitness classes were also organized by the department to improve the performance of the college teams. The teams participated at various levels like Inter-College, National, State and international level throughout the year. We are one of the topmost colleges in M.D. University in the field of games and sports.

Cultural

Our college has been blessed with an array of faculty members in music department. The college has both music vocal and instrument as optional subjects. Apart from a few instruments, college has an auditorium equipped with all latest techniques. Our college participates in all categories of dance and music events in both district and state level apart from different activities organized during youth festival by the parent university. The college can boast of the awards that our students have bagged in cultural activities. NCC REPORT

The NCC sub unit (army wing) of the college (GCW, Sec- 14, Gurugram) functioning under 2 Hr girls BN, NCC, Rohtak. The sanctioned strength is 54 cadets during the reporting year. WOMEN CELL

The Women cell of the college has five members, headed by Dr. Anita Rathi. This year the women cell organized various activities to bring awareness about gender related issues. In addition to this, various workshops on skill development were also organized.

A Lecture was organized on “Women personal health and hygiene” by Dr Shilpa Khanna on 4/01/2021. “Yoga workshop” from 06/01/2021 to 13/01/2021 (except Sundays) - was organized by renowned yoga trainer Ms. Alka Dhawan. An Extension lecture on stress and anxiety management on 11/01/2021, by Dr Brahm Deep Sindhu, Civil surgeon, Palwal was delivered. Art and craft workshop was organized in the college campus from 28/01/2021. Legal Literacy Cell

An event was organized under the Legal Literacy Cell by Ms. Munmun Goel, advocate on 7th December 2021. Madam Munmun delivered a wonderful session on eve - teasing, domestic violence, value of relationship and adjustment in family. Students will be benefited from the session.

SC Cell

To safeguard the interests of Scheduled Caste Students Govt. College for Girls, Sec 14, Gurugram has an SC cell. The cell ensures the implementation of the reservation policy about the admission of the students. It also works as a grievance redressal Cell for the grievances of SC students and employees of the college. To minimize the drop-out rate of students belonging to scheduled caste and other poor sections there is a provision for scholarships and stipends sponsored by the state and the central government. SC students are entitled to get an annual amount of 12000+ 2000 under Consolidated Stipend Scheme and Free Books to SC Students. Students staying in the hostel get 6000 extra annual amounts under the above - mentioned scheme. In the year 2020-2021, 948 SC students benefitted from the scheme.

Divyang Cell

The college has taken the initiative of dealing with the problems and difficulties of handicapped girls with sensitivity and seriousness. For this, 'Divyang' cell has been established this year under the able guidance of Mr. Ghanshyam for vision impaired girls, arrangement was made for learning computers. The cells also deals with the socioeconomics, psychological and educational problems of 'Divyang' students.

College Dispensary

There is a dispensary for the students in the college. This dispensary is working smoothly under the supervision of Dr. Pushpa Antil, Ms. Manisha Goel, Ms. Komal and Staff Nurse Smt. Meenakshi Arora. Students are given first aid and emergency treatment in the college dispensary. Dispensary also provides hostel students the facility of first aid. Serious and injured students are shifted to nearby Kalyani Hospital.

Red Cross

The Youth Red Cross society of our college organized an Online Webinar on the theme “Corona and Heart Issues” on 24th Dec 2020 in association with Narayana Super Specialty Hospital, Gurugram. The speaker of the webinar was Prof. Dr. Hemant Madan (MD Medicine, DM Cardiology, FRCPE, FSCAI) Director, Senior Consultant - Cardiology, Narayana Super Specialty Hospital. There were 105 participants in the webinar. The students learned various aspects of precautionary measures that can be taken to surpass the infections and its aftereffects related to heart, also about the methods that can avoid the implications of COVID-19 on their family members with heart problems.

In Another activity, sixteen volunteers of YRC adopted the old age people in their neighborhood in rural areas during the month of December and onwards and took care of the old people during the COVID-19 lockdown period. They helped the old people by bringing medicines for them and talking to them thus relieving their stress and fear of COVID-19. Many of them were helping by doing some general household works for the old people.

Red Ribbon Club

Various activities were organized under Red Ribbon club in session 2020-21, A short summary of some of activities is as follows:-

1. On 29th Sept. 2020 two students participated in District level online Quiz and one student from B.Sc. Medical named Ritika secured 2 nd position.
2. In December 2020 for observance of world's Aids Day, fortnight celebration was organized by RRC. In this Nail Art competition, Poster making competition, Rangoli making competition, short film making competition and online extension lecture etc. were organized by team of RRC.

3. On 18th Jan. 2021 tree decoration competition was organized for celebration National Youth Day.
4. A District level workshop for Nodal officers & peers Educators was organized on 3rd March 2021 on "HIV-AIDS". On 3rd March 2021 students registered under RRC won first position in District level Short Film Making Competition.

Road Safety Committe

Road Safety Committee in collaboration with Traffic interpretation Centre celebrated 'Sadak Suraksha Month' by organizing activities like Poster-making, Slogan writing, Traffic awareness rally and a quiz.

Soft Skill

Students have constantly been encouraged throughout the curriculum to go for higher. Every year the college organizes events and talks where students are counselled and guided for their education. The unique program where a mentor i.e., faculty member is given 50 students which helps them in their soft skill training. This is a platform where students can seek information for their career choice. Soft skills workshops too are an initiative in this very direction. During 2020-2021, one-week soft skill programme was organized in January. Value added programme is another adage that helped students to overcome the lacunas and assisted them in different areas of social behavior. Our college can boast in this regard that most of our students opt for higher education.

EARN WHILE YOU LEARN (2020-2021)

EWYL, A Govt. of Haryana funded scheme is a regular practice in the college intended to benefit genuinely needy but meritorious students by engaging them in different departments/laboratories. In lieu of work done, they are paid 100 rupees per hour. This is an initiative to promote dignity of labor and self reliance in the students. The selection process is completely transparent one, where students are judged on many factors including economic background and academic performance by a well constituted committee of senior members. In the year 2020-2021, 101 students gained financial help through the scheme. Our college was granted Rs. 20000 to be distributed among students involved. Kusum Lata, Associate Professor in Physics is convener of the committee.

Placement Cell Report

1. First ever online Zonal level job fair was organized for final year students of academic session 2020-21 in collaboration with Navjyoti Global Foundation Gurugram.
2. Online pre-job fair training was organised by Navjyoti Global Foundation, Gurugram for students belonging to various government colleges across six districts of south Haryana including Palwal, Mahendargarh, Faridabad, Nuh, Gurugram & Rewari

Mentor Mentees Scheme

Our college has been religiously following the process of maintaining the mentor- mentees system. All mentees are kept informed by their mentors about updated schemes and various workshop held in the college. Students can reach out to their mentors for any query or clarifications. These details are also available on the college website for the ease of the mentees.

Passport scheme

The State Government introduced a scheme of making passports for the UG and PG final year students in 2020-21. The decision comes as a gift from the Haryana government to students pursuing higher studies . The object is to ease the process to obtain a passport and encourage students to pursue higher education. For this purpose nodal officers were assigned and trained by the passport authorities. In Government College for Girls , Sector 14 , Gurugram, the process was headed by Mrs Archana Soota . The nodal officer was Manya Bhola and the committee had a total of 45 members . Out of the total of 2366 final year students, 1500 showed interest , their forms were filled and approximately 350 passports were successfully made well in time . The passport application fee was Rs 1500 paid by the government per student. The committee members were allotted a certain number of students under whose guidance the application forms were completed . The challans were generated and after submission to the banks , the fee was paid and the application was processed . It was followed by the appointment fixing by the students and finally the passports were issued after the police verification and document verification.

DAY CELEBRATION

Our college celebrates many national and international commemorative days, events and festivals with great enthusiasm and zeal. The institution believes in the overall development of the students and the students are on the mission to make better India. Some of the important days and events that are celebrated in our college are as follows:

‘Teachers Day’ has always been celebrated at our College highlighting the importance of teacher taught relationship. On September 14, 2020, Department of Hindi organized Hindi Poetic Recitation and Essay Writing Competition in online mode. Tree plantation drive has been undertaken throughout the rainy season. Various activities have been organised in order to cherish the spirit of nationalism on the occasion of the Birth of Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel. On October 30, 2020, poster making and slogan writing competitions were organised in which students participated with full enthusiasm. We also celebrated ‘National Education Day’ on November 12, 2020 and organized Poetic compositions Contest and Essay writing Competition. Future Plans

1. Six smart classrooms in addition to 10 existing smart classrooms are also proposed to enhance the effectiveness of teaching learning process.
2. Covid has taught us the necessity of digitalisation so the focus of next academic year would be on the blended mode of learning through ICT tools. Mentor groups played an important role during Covid pandemic in not only passing the information but also engaging with the students in academic and nonacademic discourses. Efforts would be made to make mental mentees groups more functional.
3. Plan to set up MCA Computer lab estimated cost 50 lakhs for better teaching and learning experience for Bca students and teachers.
4. Plan for the construction of new academic block. Plan for the reconstruction of dilapidated boundary wall of GCG sector 14 Gurugram with the estimated cost of around 30 lakhs.
5. Plan to set up MCA lab for the larger interest of students worth 50,00,000
6. Plan to set up multipurpose hall for hosting national and international conferences/seminars quest lecturers/presentations with approximately cost 70,00,000
7. Plan to conduct workshops / seminars / industry visits / conferences. Our chief priorities is to provide clean and safe drinking water to the students and the staff of the college. For this purpose, it is planned to install industrial RO of thousand litre capacity in girls hostel. Request for the same has been sent to area head HDFC bank Limited sector 53 Gurugram under CSR fund of bank to help the college in this initiative.
8. We have sent the plan for the requirement for creation of sports facilities/Development of herbal Park/new toilet block for girls students in college campus
9. For the smooth conduct of office working, we intend to send a request to DGHE Panchkula for the purchase of essential items for administrative office. There is a plan to utilise hostel lapse security of Rs. 59 lakhs for the utility commodities of girls hostel. Plan to improve the physical infrastructure in the administrative blocks, staffroom, classrooms, labs and teaching faculty rooms. The estimated amount for this project is 49 lakhs. Under the CSR installation of solar PV power plant is planned on College building roof. The cost will be met by CSR fund of SBI cards. Keeping in view the changing educational, social and economic scenario of the society, the institute has a perspective plan for development while keeping in view the ideas of excellence, truth and service. Some proposals have been sent to HEC seeking more funds for the merged Schemes, the extension of girls hostel, books journals, equipment, smart classrooms et cetera to improve the teaching learning quality.
